## 'Future Economic Regulation of the Broadband Market'

Please find Jersey Airtel & Guernsey Airtel's joint response to the above consultation dated 04th May 2018:

Thank you for including us in 'broadband market' review, we appreciate & welcome this exercise and below are inputs/comments from us:

- 1. We offer a 4G internet product 'home broadband' which was very well received by 'cost conscious' segment of the market who prefer not to pay two sets of rental for landline & broadband each including admin/installation charges from competitors in the market, however, we have now deliberately slowed down the promotion of this product due to huge constraints from high pricing of leased lines/backhaul/ISP, hence, if CICRA can regulate and bring down pricing of leased lines/backhaul/ISP then 4G/LTE/5G internet product could be a nice & niche alternative to wired fibre/copper broadband for thousands of islanders.
- 2. Suggest CICRA to identify areas where fibre or copper can't reach, or data experience is an issue.... Perhaps 4G/LTE/5G internet product could be an alternative and site planning can be done.
