



Notice of a Proposed Decision to grant a Licence to

Fuel Supplies (C.I.) Limited trading as

Rubis Channel Islands

Issue of an Electricity Generation Licence in Guernsey

The Guernsey Competition and Regulatory Authority (**GCRA**) has received an application from Fuel Supplies (C.I.) Limited trading as Rubis Channel Islands, a company registered in Guernsey, no. 409, registered address, Bulwer Avenue, St Sampson, Guernsey, GY1 3EB.

The GCRA supports the objectives in paragraph 1.11 of the States Energy Policy 2020-2050, which states:

“The Energy Policy also seeks to enable Guernsey’s emissions reduction targets to be in part achieved, including through on-island renewable energy generation, by facilitating targeted competition within the electricity market to enable potential additional renewable or low carbon energy operators to serve the market.”

and through its legal powers under section 2 of the *Electricity (Guernsey) Law, 2001*, proposes to issue a Licence for Electricity Generation to Fuel Supplies (C.I.) Limited trading as Rubis Channel Islands.

The GCRA notes, that in its licence application, Rubis Channel Islands proposes to supply electricity from renewable electricity equipment installed in client premises and to only

undertake supply activities in connection with renewable electricity generation at the point of use.

Therefore, GCRA does not propose to issue a supply licence or grant any specific exemption on the basis that such supply is within the scope of the general supply exemption contained in Office of Utility Regulation Direction 02/06¹.
