



## **Statement of Objections**

The Guernsey Competition and Regulatory Authority (**GCRA**) and the Jersey Competition Regulatory Authority (**JCRA**)<sup>1</sup> have issued a draft decision (**Statement of Objections**) alleging that JT<sup>2</sup> and Sure<sup>3</sup> have breached Guernsey competition law and Jersey competition law by entering into anti-competitive arrangements/agreements in relation to the construction and operation of 5G networks in Guernsey and in Jersey.

No conclusion should be drawn that there has been an infringement of competition law at this stage and the recipients of the Statement of Objections will now have the opportunity to respond to the allegations.

CICRA will consider any representations it receives before any decision is taken as to whether Guernsey competition law and/or Jersey competition law have in fact been infringed.
